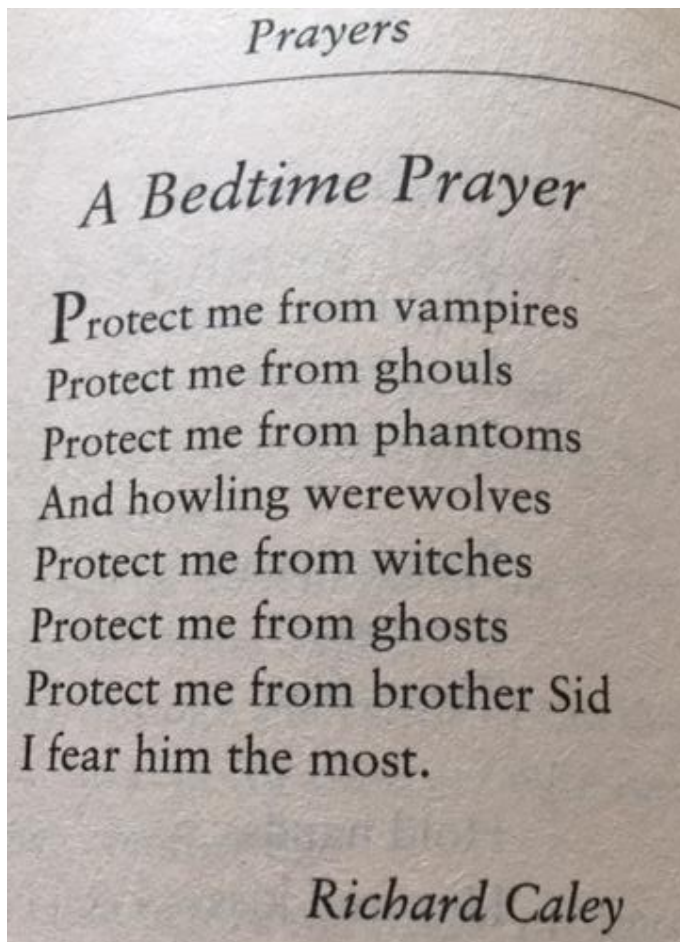

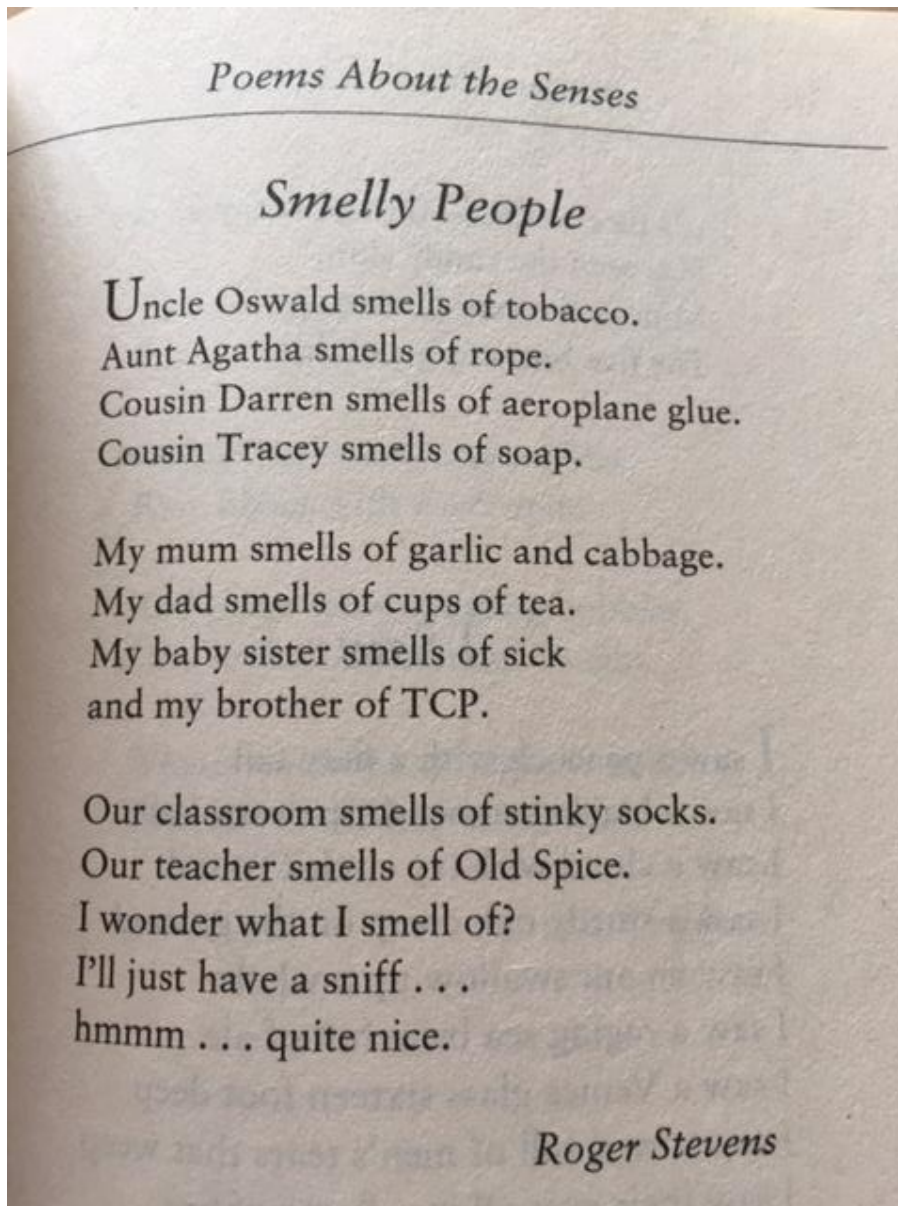

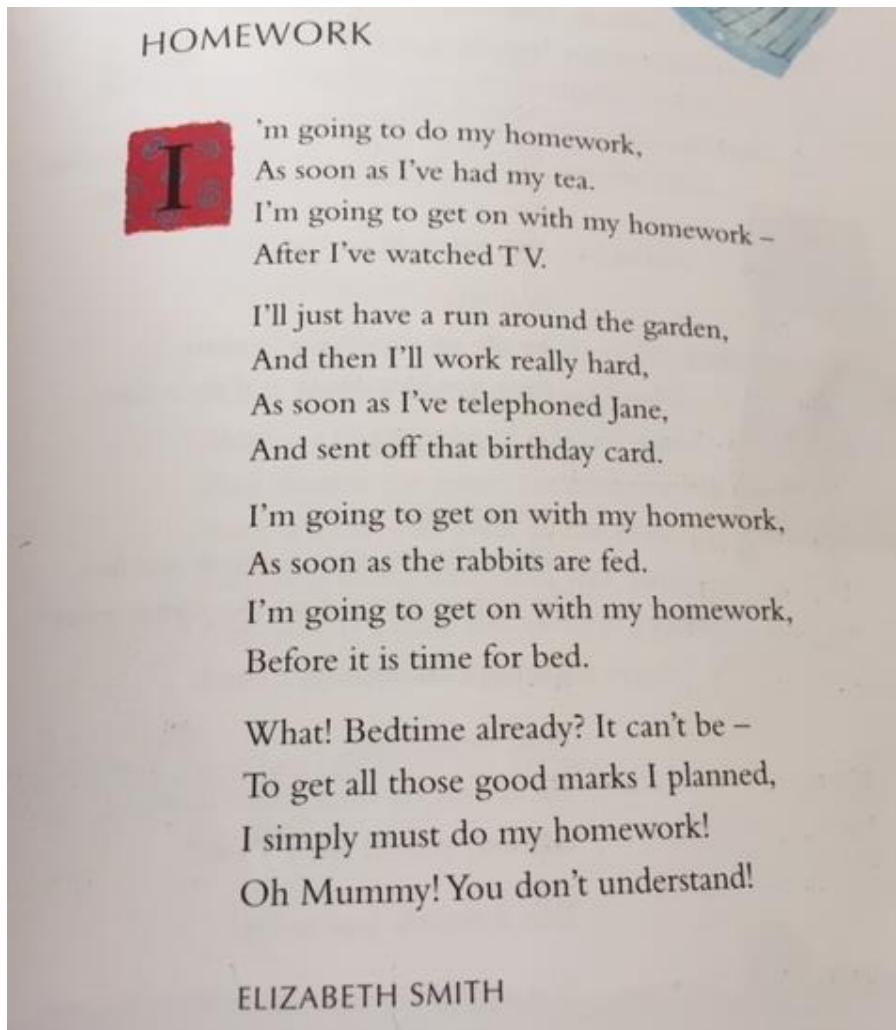

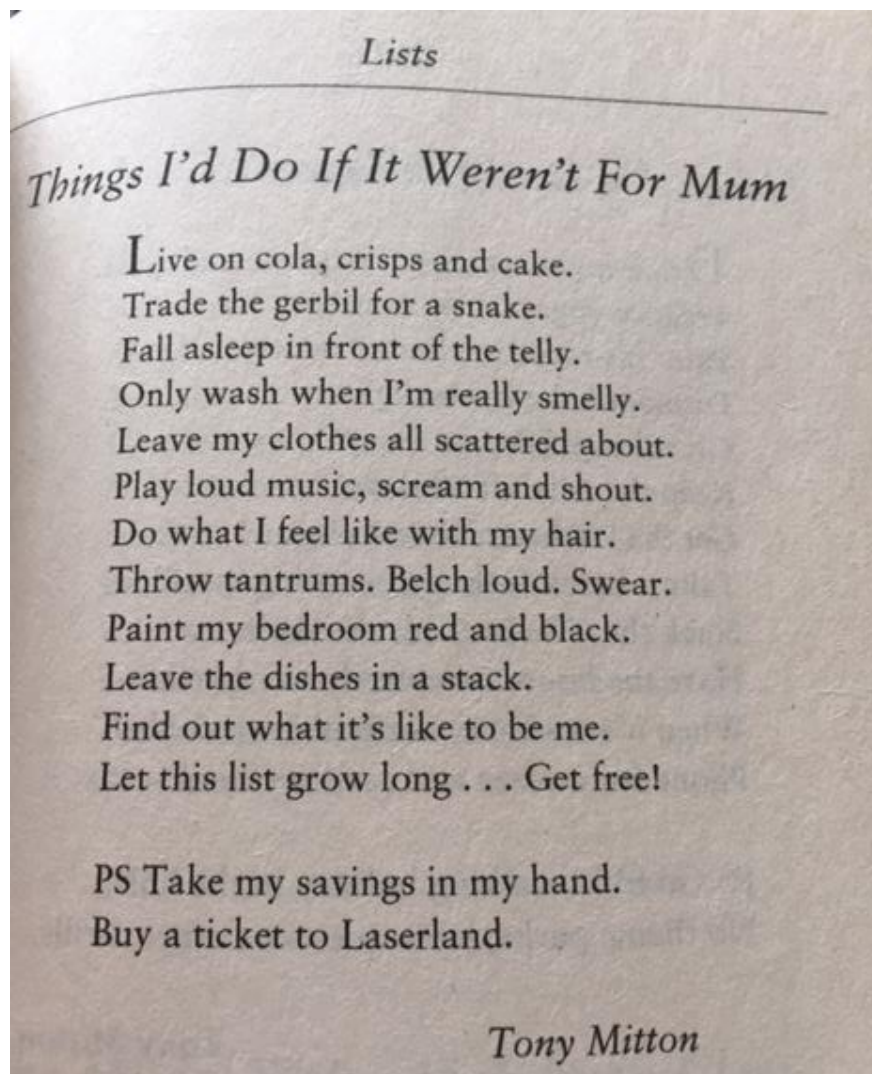

And quiet sleep and a sweet dream when the long trick's over.

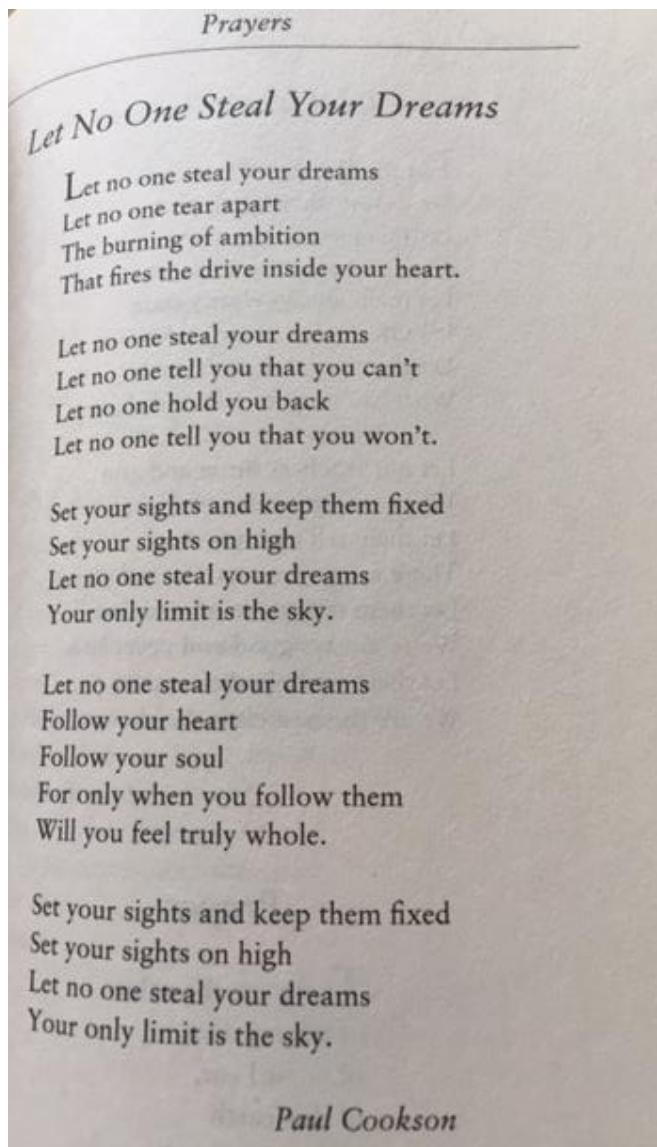

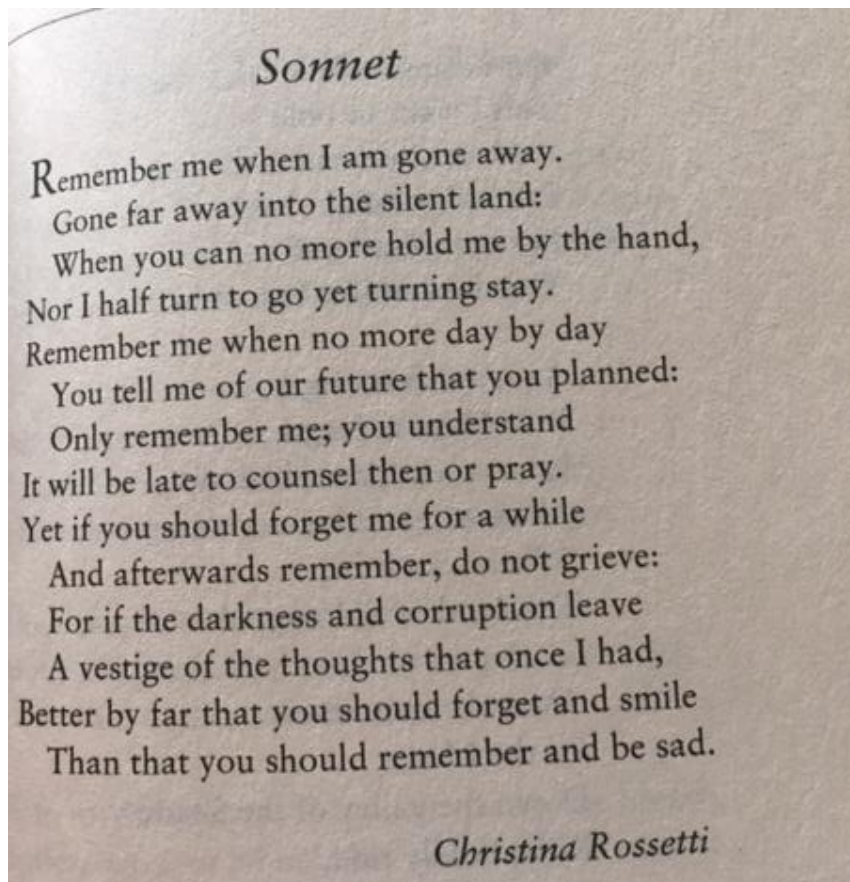
