CRAFT SECTION RULES

1. Amateurs only.

2. Booking a time slot for entry. https://nuneatonfestivalofarts.eventbrite.co.uk/ Bookings open Friday 23rd February 2024

3. Entry form - Please bring a completed entry form together with your work and entry fee to the **KEC 'W' BUILDING on entry day**. To comply with the Safeguarding Policy procedures the official Nuneaton Festival of Arts entry form MUST be completed and signed.

4. **Insurance form**- Please bring a completed Insurance form with the above when bringing in your entry. Retain your receipt safely as it will be needed when you collect your work at the end of the exhibition.

(Both forms are found at back of syllabus or download from Festival website)

5. Payment - may be made by cheque (payable to Nuneaton Festival of Arts), cash, BACS or bank card.

6. Entries - Only <u>ONE</u> entry allowed per individual and <u>FIVE</u> individual entries per school or group. Group entries (more than one person contributing to one piece) <u>ONE</u> entry per group. If you do not find a class for your entry, please bring your work along and we will find a class to fit your work. All work must be original.

7. **Sizes** - as there is limited exhibition space, please note the size required in the section you are entering

<u>NB</u> Oversized GROUP entries can be adjudicated, but due to reduced hanging space it may not be hung or displayed. Please contact Section Secretary before the entry day.

8. Late entries- cannot be accepted

9. Labels - All 2D work must have two labels with name, (and school or group if applicable) title of work and Festival class number one on the back of the work and one attached by string to the back of entry so that it can be seen clearly when hung over the face of the work.

3D work - If fabric please attach one label attached with a string with a safety pin. Other 3D please attach a label on a string appropriately to your material. Please note most of these items will be open display. See page 6 (B).

(Schools may put child's name on front if they wish to)

10. **Framing** -If framing your entry, the framing needs to be firm, rigid and sturdy in good condition and appropriate to the size of work. See framing guidance notes on page 6 and 7.

11. **Display Cases**-We cannot guarantee your work will be displayed in a case.

12. **Collection** - You will be able to sign up for a collection slot when you bring your entry.

13. **Results** -Will be available 3 days after the adjudication on the Festival's website and if you have been given an award you will be notified by the Section Secretary with details of the presentation.

14. LATE COLLECTION WILL BE CHARGED AT £1 PER DAY AND NO RESPONSIBILTY WILL BE TAKEN FOR CONDITION OF ENTRIES AFTER THIS DATE. THEY WILL BE DISPOSED OF AFTER 2 WEEKS.

3D Mixed Media - Using materials in a creative way to create a 3D form (all round vision) e.g. pipe cleaners, art straws, recycled materials, man-made materials, natural materials, etc. Gluing and sewing allowed. Maximum size: 100cm x 80cm Festival of Arts Trophy: Under 18's - Best individual entry - Adjudicator's discretion



Craft Conditions and Guidance Notes 2024

A. <u>Introduction</u>: The aim of these arrangements is to ensure the smooth running, good hanging and security of your work. Exhibits will be displayed in the King Edwards College 'W' Building, Rope Walk, Nuneaton. NFoA volunteers will arrange and hang work. Entrant's work must be brought in and collected on specified dates. NFoA decision on inclusion will be final

B. Framing of Work (Framing details overleaf).

- For displays all framed works must be securely screw eyed and strung ready for hanging; those not strung cannot be displayed. The framing needs to be firm, rigid, study in good condition and appropriate to the size of the work. Clip frames are not appropriate.
- <u>School works/unframed works:</u> These works may be stapled, or blu tacked which may cause damage to the corners.
- <u>Craft 3D Work:</u> Please note that many of these items are on open display. We reserve the right not to display if they constitute a health and safety issue eg loose nails, screws or sharp edges.

D. Acceptance of Work:

- On deposit of work, NFoA's volunteers will check off the condition of the works and entrants will be given a receipt. Please bring this receipt on collection day. You will be able to sign up for a collection slot on entry day,
- All works shall continue to be displayed until the official end of the exhibition, when they will be available for collection.
- Results will be available 3 days after adjudication on the Festival's website.

- KEC and NFoA do not accept responsibility for loss or damage to articles lent for temporary exhibitions, unless such loss or damage arises directly as a result of negligence on the part of the KECS or NFoA.


